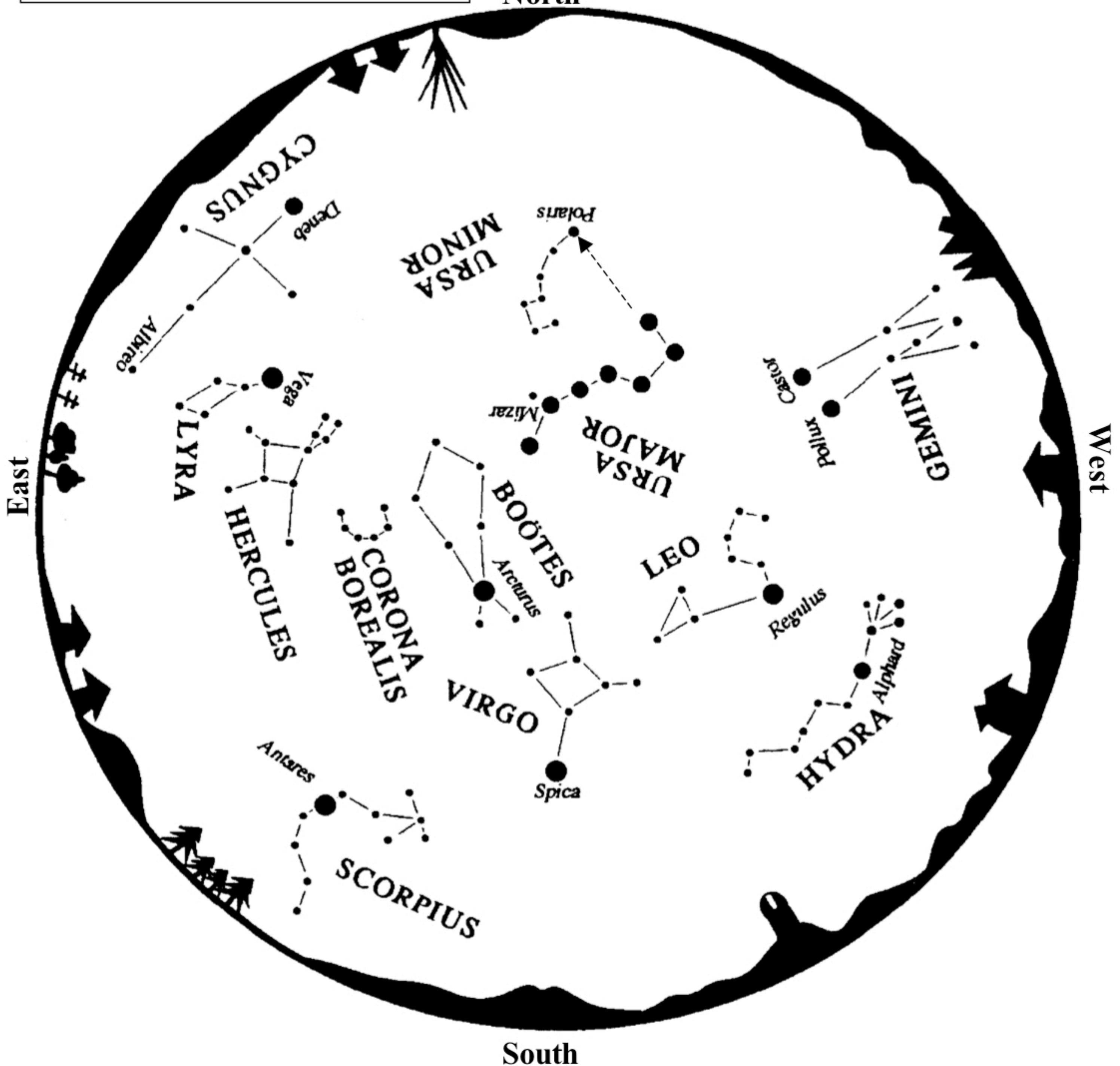


# Evening Star Map for May-June

To use map:

Hold the map so that the direction you are facing is at the bottom. (*Reminder: The Sun sets roughly in the WEST. If you are facing WEST, just make 1 quarter turn to the left and you will be facing SOUTH.*)

You can also hold the map above your head with the direction you are facing at the bottom.

Look for the brightest stars at first. They are the larger black dots on the map.

Sometimes, planets may also be visible among the stars. Look for bright 'star like' objects that do not twinkle.
